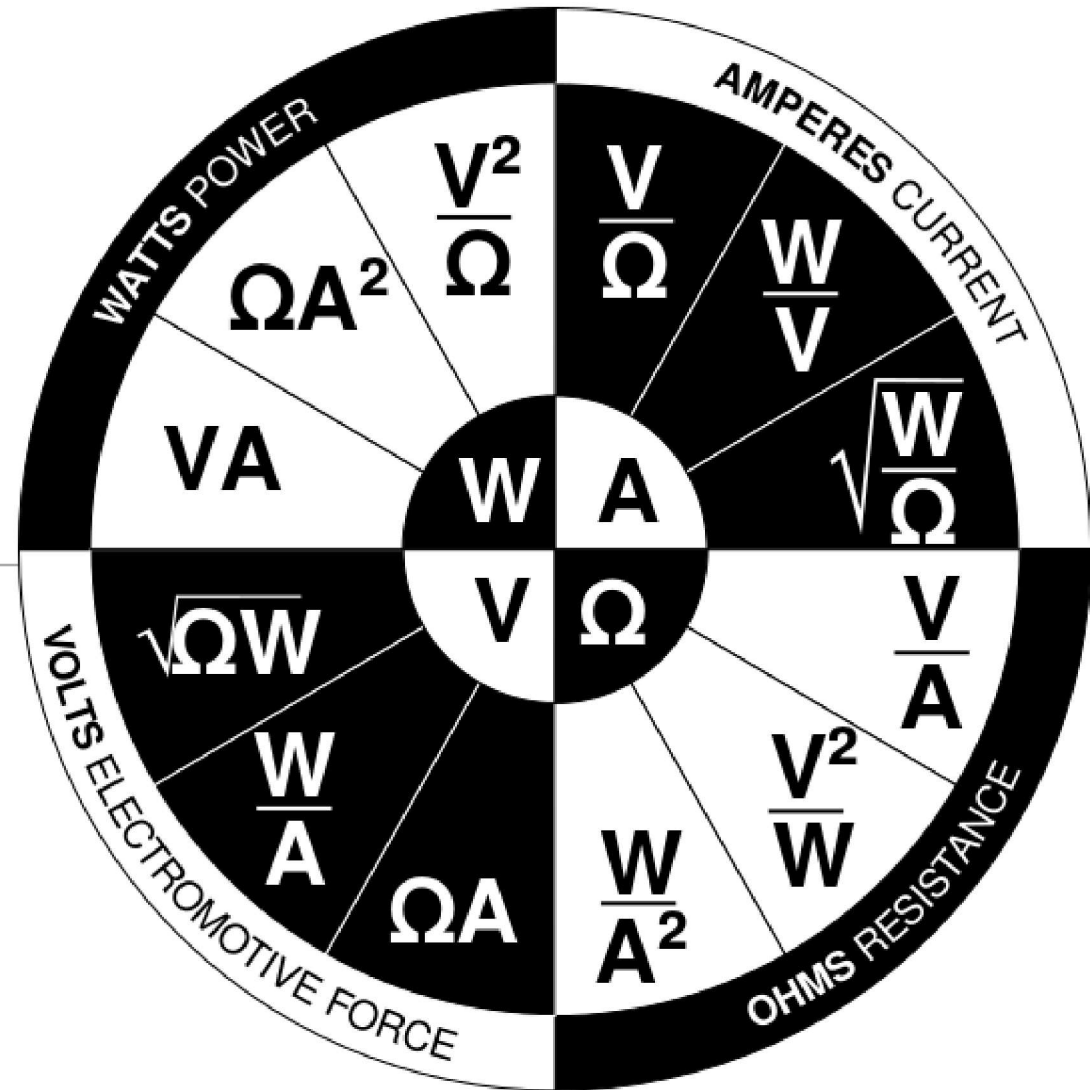

<b>Description</b>	<b>English:</b> Simplified Ohm's law wheel using unit symbols. This is specially useful for teaching Ohm's law to young students. Note: VA (volt amps) has been substituted for W (watts), which is approximately the same in most cases, but can be vastly different in large systems (see <u>power factor</u> ).
